**4. To consider Planning Application 2020/0506**

Location: Land East of Ipswich Road Saxlingham Thorpe Norfolk

Proposal: Change of use from agricultural land to equestrian use, with associated fencing and field shelters, plus installation of new access track.

Adrienne Watts had viewed the plans and advised that whilst the majority of the application falls within Saxlingham it does abut the Parish boundary on the south side. The application from Redwings includes upgrading fences, gateways and shelter buildings.

The application also proposes to remove a dangerous gate opening onto the A140 and replace with a new kissing gate/stile to the section which crosses the Boudicca Way. There are no neighbouring properties which would be adversely affected and no objections to the application online.
