1. Election of Chair

Location: Mistletoe Cottage, Marlpit Lane, Tasburgh Norfolk

Proposal: Solar panels on the south facing pitched roof on the newly converted outbuilding.

Location: Land adjacent to Howard Low Road Tasburgh Norfolk

Proposal: Amended plans for new chalet bungalow
